WHITBY, ON – Durham Region Transit (DRT) wants you to celebrate safely this New Year's Eve: on Tuesday, Dec. 31, after 8 p.m., residents and visitors to the Region can ride all DRT services for free! DRT is offering extended service, including late night shuttles from GO Stations, until 3 a.m.

"At DRT safety is always paramount," says Bill Holmes, General Manager of DRT. "During the festive season and on New Year's Eve, we want everyone to make the right choice. When out celebrating, have a designated driver or use DRT so everyone on the roads gets home safely."
